YEAR 1



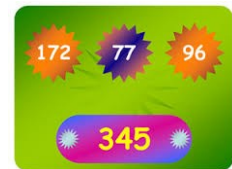

We have been adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers on a number line. We have also been very busy writing our own Greek myth and/or legend.



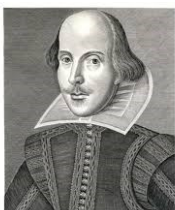
YEARS 4-5
